

Capacity Development on Disaster Resilience Leadership (DRL)

 The RSO participated in a Workshop on Disaster Resilience Leadership (DRL).
One of the major focus was Basic
Methodologies in Hazard and Risk Assessment.
The training workshop is part of the global intervention for Strengthening Leadership in Disaster Resilience Program (SLDRP) with funding support from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.





2016/2017 Activities

Land Degradation Neutrality Target Setting Programme

- The RSO participated in the working group for Setting Land Degradation Neutrality Target as well as the development of methodology for conducting assessment of Land degradation in Nigeria.
- The hotspots for degradation have been identified using space technology.
- The programme is supported by the Global Support Programme through the UNCCD

2016/2017 Activities

Assessment of Environmental Sensitivity to Desertification

- The RSO is implementing a project with focus on the assessment of environmental sensitivity to desertification in a Northern Nigeria state called Katsina.
- The Goal is to identify areas that are prone to desertification so that early warnings efforts as well as adequate Government policy can be developed.

UN-REDD+ Programme Implementation

- The RSO is currently involved in the preparation and policy document developments for the UNREDD+ programme in Nigeria.
- Such efforts has led to the development of UNREDD+ strategy document for Nigeria.
- Nigeria is in the readiness phase and currently planning to transit to the implementation and piloting phase.
